



Step 1: Color the pictures (you can also wait until everything is cut, glued and dried if needed).

Step 2: Cut out all 6 rectangles.

Step 3: Match the numbered 'A' rectangles to their corresponding 'B' rectangles (1A to 1B, etc.) and glue them together with the pictures facing out.

Step 5: After the rectangles have dried, place glue on the thin strip marked off by the dotted line ONLY. The glue should go on the side with the blank strip on the LEFT.

Step 6: Glue rectangle 1 onto the line labeled "1". The blank, numbered strip should be on the RIGHT side.

Step 7: Follow steps 2 and 3 with your remaining rectangles and lines. The rectangles will overlap—this is ok!

Step 8: Flip rectangles to reveal a bus with a bully and a bus with an upstander!
